Democratic eparticipation

Article 9 of Legislative Decree No. 82 of 2005

1. The Public Administrations, shall encourage all forms of use of new technologies to promote greater participation of citizens, including those residing abroad, in the democratic process and to facilitate the exercise of political and civil rights and improve the quality of their acts, including through the use, where provided for and within the resources available under current legislation, of forms of prior consultation by telematic means on the proposals for acts to be adopted.

Right to simple, integrated online services


Article 7 Legislative Decree No. 82/2005

- 1. Public administrations shall reorganize and modernize the services provided, based on a preliminary analysis of the real needs of users and make their services available online in compliance with the provisions of this Code and the standards and quality levels identified and periodically updated by the Agency for Digital Italy with its own Guidelines also taking into account technological evolution.
- 3. For online services, public administrations, **allow users to express satisfaction** with respect to the quality, including usability, accessibility and responsiveness, of the service provided to them and publish the results, including usage statistics, on their sites.


